## No smoking



### Policy statement

We comply with health and safety regulations and the Welfare Requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage curriculum in making our setting a no-Smoking environment - both indoors and outdoors.

### Procedures

- All staff, parents and volunteers are made aware of our No Smoking Policy.
- We display no Smoking signs.
- The No Smoking Policy is stated in our information brochure for parents.
- We actively encourage no Smoking by having information for parents and staff about where to get help to stop Smoking if they are seeking this information.
- Staff who smoke do not do so during working hours. Unless on a break and off the premises.
- Staff who smoke during their break make every effort to reduce the effect of the odour and lingering effects of passive Smoking for children and colleagues.
