Children going to school in September

As the older children are nearing the time to go to 'Big school' we would like you to encourage them to become more independent.

Can they put on their own clothes including socks, shoes and coats? Please put them in shoes that are easy for them to put on and take off by themselves e.g. Velcro - not laces. Support them to do zips or buttons on their coats.

Let them help you write birthday cards and shopping lists and encourage them to look for signs and numbers in the environment.

Put items in their lunchboxes that they can open themselves, let them attempt to open their own crisp packets. For cooked meals, show them how to use a knife and fork, can they cut up their own food?

We will be shortening their lunch time as some of the children can be sat at the table for over an hour and they will not get this long at school.

These are all recommendations from the Infants schools.
