Can we also ask that children wear suitable footwear on sunny days, flip flops and some sandals can cause sore feet when worn without socks and are just not safe to wear when climbing on equipment, running or riding bikes.

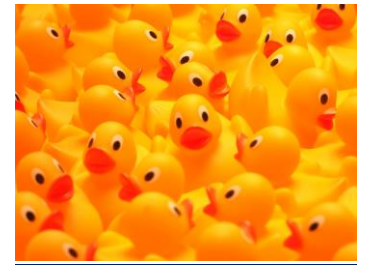
Safeguarding and Welfare
