Graduation Picnic

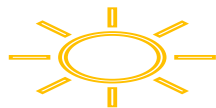
The committee would like you **all** to come to the Leavers Picnic on Thursday 20th July 11.30am-1.30pm.

NSPCC – TALK PANTS (protecting children from sexual abuse)

Young children are just as vulnerable as their older peers. For children in this age group a simplified form of awareness education is key, TALK PANTS from the NSPCC has this objective in mind. It helps children understand that their body belongs to them and they should tell someone they trust if they are upset or worried.
