Sun cream and Outdoor play



As it's the summer term, let's hope we have some sunny days to look forward to in the coming weeks. **Should this happen please remember to apply sun cream to your child before they come into Preschool and supply them with a sunhat (labelled with their name). They may still need a waterproof coat also.**

If your child stays at Preschool for lunch, they will need to have their sun cream reapplied. **Therefore, we ask that you provide the sun cream to remain in Preschool. Please label this with your child's name.**

Can we also ask that children wear suitable footwear, flip flops, crocs and some sandals can cause sore feet when worn without socks and are not safe to wear when climbing on equipment, running or riding bikes.

!! Oral health !!

There is an increasing amount of sugary food items being put in the children's lunchboxes and water bottles that are containing squash. Children should have access to water throughout the day and not continually drink squash.

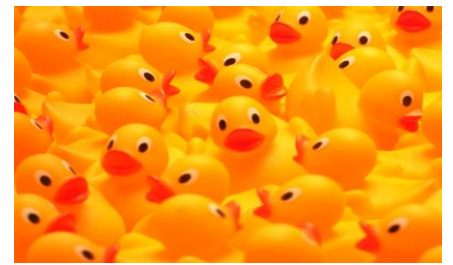
We have to follow the EYFS statutory guidance which states that 'Providers must promote the good health, including the oral health, of the children they look after'.

We make sure the children are drinking from their water bottles throughout the day.

Please make sure your child brings their water bottle every time they attend a session, it should be clearly labelled with their name and only contain water. A separate drink can be put in their lunchbox, which can contain squash or juice.
